
2022 Chairman's Report

The Credit Union expanded its field of membership in 2022 in order to serve more people who live in our local community. The charter expansion opens the door to many residents within Multnomah and Clackamas counties located near the Credit Union's main branch. Based on where you live, work, attend school or worship more people than ever can also join Castparts Credit Union and participate as an owner in our non-profit financial cooperative.

To welcome newly eligible potential members, the Credit Union advertised on bulletin boards and sent mailers to homes and businesses within the expanded community. The Credit Union offered a 5.00% APR Debt Consolidation loan to help community members struggling to payoff high-rate debt find an answer to improving their financial situation.

The Credit Union has continued to demonstrate its commitment to Precision Castparts, Corp. and employees by installing a new Video Teller / ATM at the SSBO plant location in 2022. In addition to the new Video Teller / ATM at the main branch, a second Video Teller / ATM was installed at the SSBO plant. You can use the machines in ATM mode 24/7, or you can access a staff member by video M-F, 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM who can assist with your deposit, withdrawal, transfer, payment or inquiry.



You can also reach staff using the chat feature from the Credit Union's website, where video is an additional option to the chat feature.

Castparts Credit Union continues to enhance remote services, designed to make your account access more convenient. For the past few years, The Credit Union has been focusing on helping members financially prepare to buy a home. With rental prices increasing and the ability to find homes challenging, the Credit Union works with members to put them in the best position to qualify for a mortgage loan. The Credit Union can help you get started and prepare for your future purchase.

There are two Certified Financial Counselor on staff at the Credit Union who will review your credit report with you and help you determine what you need to do to qualify for a home loan now or in the future. If you are interested in a "financial check-up" schedule this free service today!

When you visit Castparts Credit Union, you will notice some changes. The lobby was remodeled to better utilize the space and the rest of the building was also refreshed and updated.

2022 Supervisory Committee Report

The Supervisory Committee is an integral part of Castparts Employees Federal Credit Union and is an extension of the Board of Directors and the representative for the membership. The Supervisory Committee has the responsibility to conduct audits designed to determine that accounting records and reports are prepared accurately utilizing audit standards generally accepted in the US (GAAP) that reflect the financial operations of the Credit Union.

The Supervisory Committee also determines that all Internal Controls are effectively maintained and adequately protect the Credit Union, its members, its management and its employees.

The Supervisory Committee utilizes Internal and External Auditors that perform these audits of the Credit Union's Policies, Procedures and Financials for compliance. It includes physical verification of the Credit Union's Assets, verification of adequate internal controls, security and safeguards, and compliance with the rules and regulations for Federal Credit Unions.

We have completed all required audits covering Internal Controls and Financials which comprise the statements of financial condition as of June 30, 2022 and related statements of income, change in members' equity, and cash flows for the year ended. Additionally, audits of policies and procedures covering many aspects of operations.

It is our opinion, based upon the Internal Audits and the External Financial Audit, we find Castparts Credit Union in compliance with all Federal requirements for credit unions.
